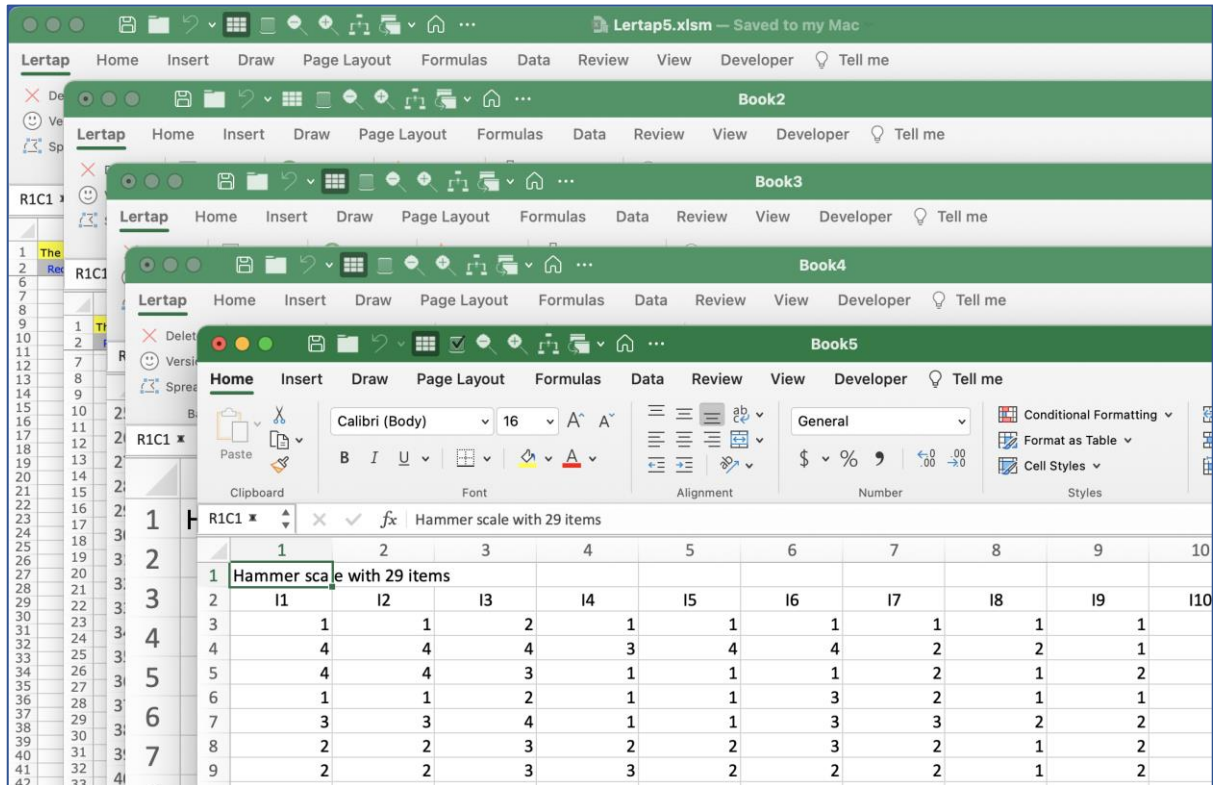


Mac Lertap5 Screenshots, 31 May 2021

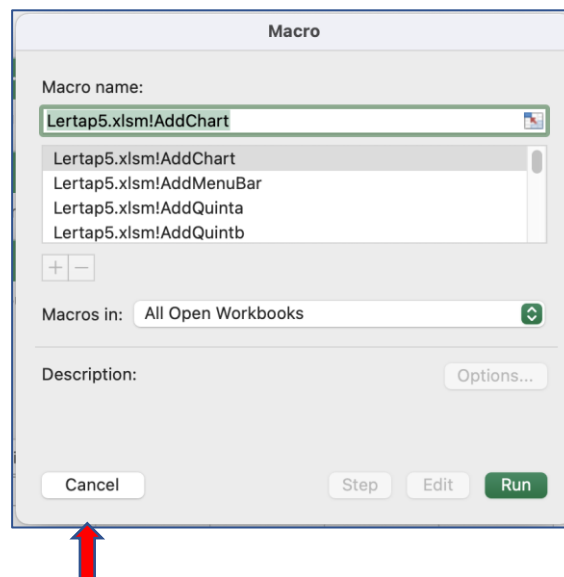
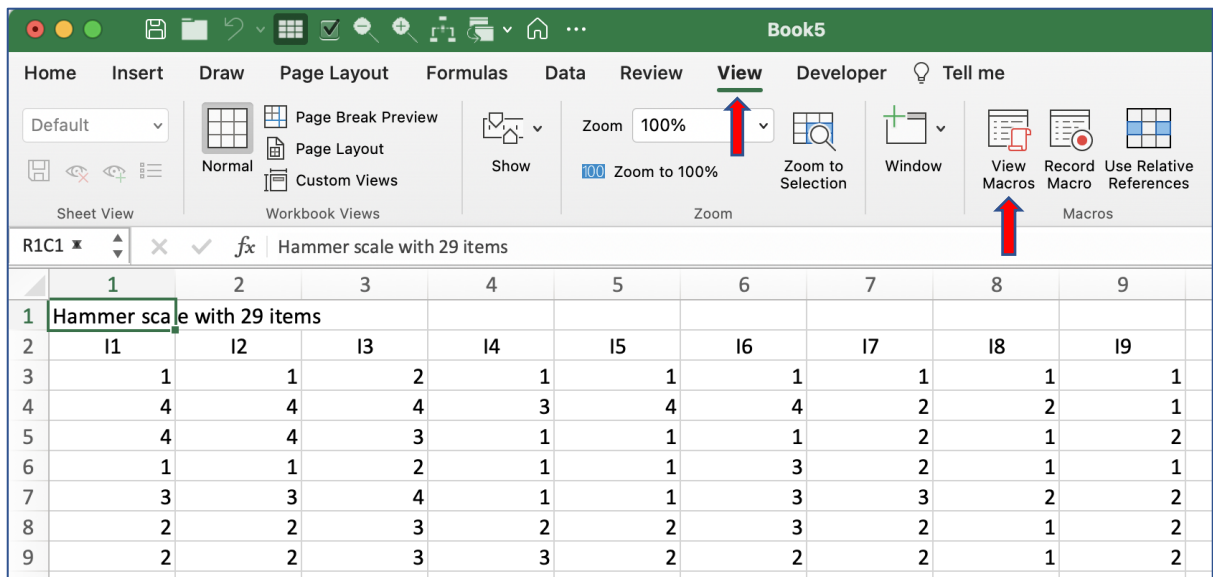
The screen captures seen below were taken on a MacBook Pro after the Lertap5.xlsm workbook had been opened with Microsoft Excel for Mac.



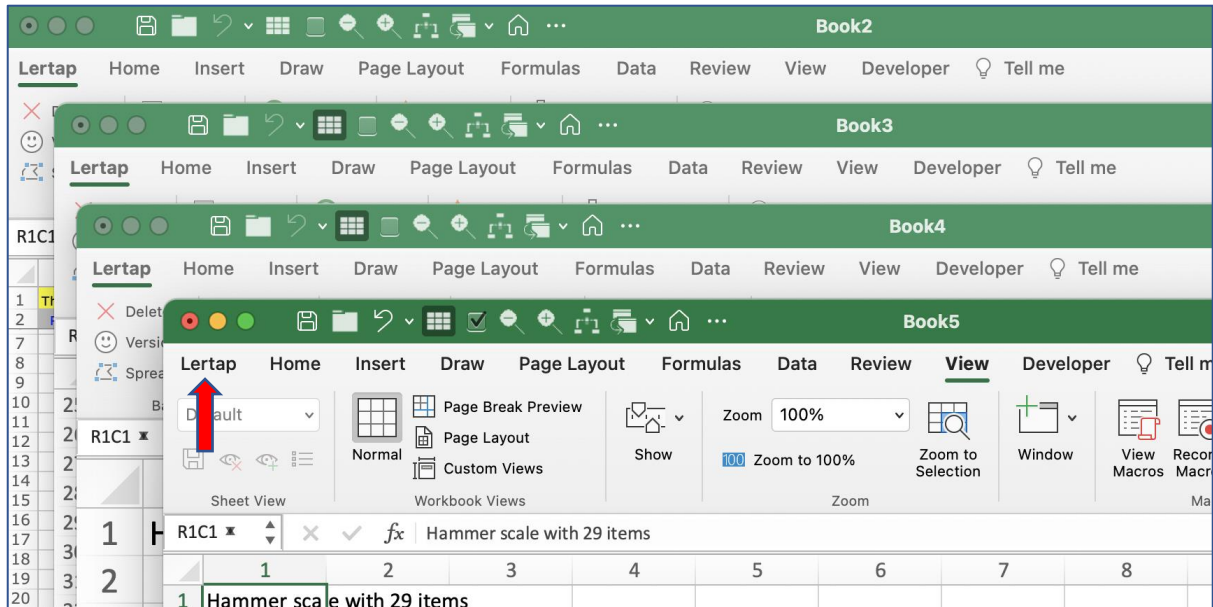
The snapshot above displays a problem that can at times arise when running Lertap5 using Excel on Macintosh computers: the Lertap tab may will be missing from the Excel ribbon, as seen above for Book 5.

On a Mac, the first tab on an Excel ribbon should be the Lertap tab – above it's absent from Book5's ribbon where **Home** has become the first tab.

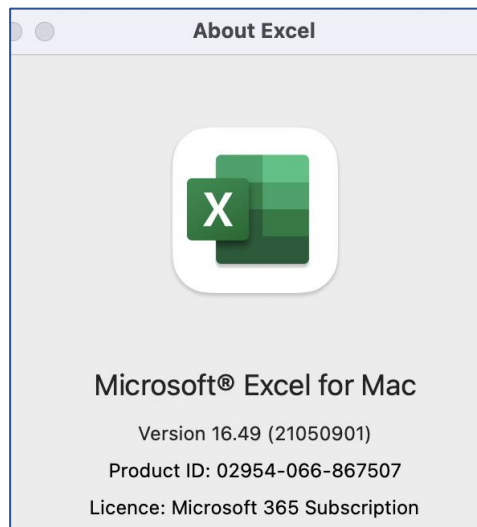
To recover the Lertap tab, one solution is to click on the View tab to the right of the Review tab, followed by a click on View Macros:



And then click on Cancel – the **Lertap** tab should be restored on Book5, as seen below:
